

## GUIDELINES FOR THE PROCEEDINGS OF NAMLS-9 IN JRNC

Registered participants with accepted *and* presented communications – oral or poster – are cordially invited to submit the corresponding full papers for evaluation and tentative publication in a special issue of the *Journal of Radioanalytical and Nuclear Chemistry*.

Each manuscript is allowed a **maximum** of 12 pages, in Times New Roman 12-pt font, with *very* generous margins – **not more** than 24 lines per page, double-spaced through the whole document, and **not more** than 60 characters per line. The former limits apply to **every** section of a manuscript, including abstract (50-100 words), acknowledgements (if any), references and captions (grouped on an individual page). In brief, *everything must* fit into 12 pages, *without* exceeding 24 lines/page and 60 characters/line, *and without* short-changing the *Instructions for Authors* of the *Journal of Radioanalytical and Nuclear Chemistry* (see next).

Other than the above (specific) requirements for NAMLS-9, the general preparation of manuscripts **must** strictly follow the *Instructions for Authors* of the JRNC, available in HTML and PDF at <http://www.springer.com/chemistry/journal/10967>, except for the submission mode. Recent issues of the Journal may also provide additional information as to typesetting and/or formatting requirements (equations, units, table layouts, etc) not explicitly given in the *Instructions for Authors*.

Manuscripts are due on **Monday, September 8**, at the Conference Desk. Three high-quality, black-and-white copies per manuscript, plus an electronic version in CD-ROM or memory stick, are required for submission. Word 97-2003 Document [\* .doc] and Rich Text Format [\* .rtf] are the *only* acceptable formats – [\* .docx] or [\* .pdf] files will **not** be accepted. Please do **not** include any names and acronyms in the filenames; files should be named after the corresponding abstracts' codes, i.e., [A####.doc] or [A####.rtf].

All submissions are going to be pre-screened upon delivery to the Conference Desk. **Manuscripts that fail to comply with the present guidelines will not be checked in.**
